- OSHA 1910.179 states that only designated personnel shall be permitted to operate a crane.
- · As defined by OSHA, designated means selected or assigned by the employer as being qualified to perform special duties.
- ASME B30.2 states that operators shall be required by the employer to pass a practical operating examination.
- CMAA Specification 78 states that a Pre-shift inspection shall be performed at the start of each shift or when it is first used during each shift.
- OSHA, ASME, & CMAA all state that frequent inspections shall be performed on daily or monthly intervals based on service, environmental and application factors.
